

ICON selected among field of seven as the architect for the new Crosby Ice arena and Curling rink.

Members of the Northwest Health and Wellness Center steering committee announced the hiring of a lead contractor for construction of a new multi-purpose center. With groundbreaking pegged for next month, the committee chose ICON Architectural Group to lead the design phase of the project.

“All along we’ve said our first phase is going to be that multi-purpose arena,” Steering Committee Chairman David Olson said, which includes ice for hockey and curling as well as room for exhibitions and fair events.

Olson said ICON earned the project in that ICON proved its willingness to work closely with the committee to meet its goals and budget. “We’ve been taking good steps forward here.”

The total cost of phase one is \$3 million, but final figures will not be available until ICON completes the design work. The committee is optimistic that some activities can commence in the new facility at some point next year.

Earlier this month, ICON’s dual rink ice project in Omaha, NE also broke ground towards completion for the 2012 ice seasons.
